ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS Florida's 11 Regional Planning Councils

- Designated by U.S. Economic Development Administration as Economic Development Districts.
- Charged by EDA to develop and adopt a Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) through a CEDS Committee.





Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy = CEDS PLAN

- Analyzes regional economy, guides regional goals
 & objectives, identifies investment priorities and funding sources.
- Creates a road map to economic diversity through private sector investment and job creation.
- Serves as vehicle to justify and draw down federal funds.

- Offer loans to small and medium size businesses (all types) from \$50,000 to \$300,000
- Has been at the Council for the past 10 years
- Created and/or retained more than 2,100 jobs
- Assisted over 100 businesses
- Private/Public investment for RLF projects exceeds \$15 million
- Recognized as one of the best managed Revolving Loan programs in the country by the Council of Development Finance Agencies


