

SUBJECT: 2023 Adjusted Lower Living Standard Income Level Wage Rates

PURPOSE

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity publishes the Adjusted Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) Wage Rates each year upon converting the LLSIL to an hourly wage. The hourly wage rates are used as baseline data in state-generated performance reports such as the monthly management report and may be used by local workforce development boards for other purposes such as the locally required definition for employment that leads to self-sufficiency.

The following tables reflect the adjusted wage rates. The wage rates are adjusted for each local workforce development area based on the Florida Price Level Index (FPLI).
