FL WINS Overview

House Bill 1507

Established the Reimagining Education and Career Help (REACH) Act.

- FloridaCommerce coordinates this important initiative with the REACH Office, the Florida Department of Children and Families, the Florida Department of Education, CareerSource Florida and Florida Digital Service.

The REACH Act

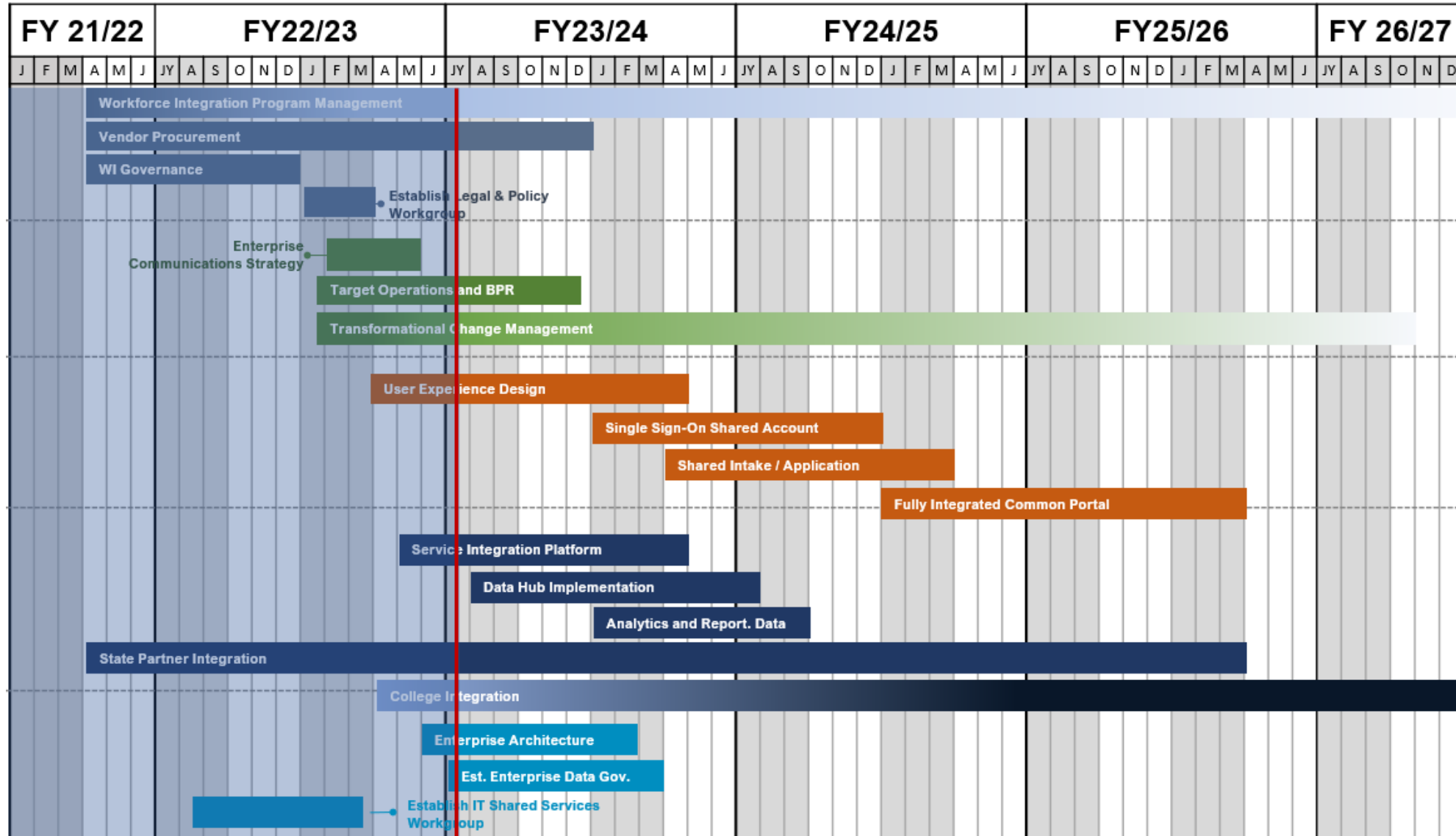
- Strategically aligns education and workforce initiatives across Florida agencies. This includes a no-wrong-door entry strategy through the development and implementation of a customer portal which will provide Floridians with broader access to education and training options, labor market information, career planning tools, workforce training, and education support, regardless of which “door” in the workforce development system the customer enters.

FL WINS Program

- The FL WINS Program includes a series of projects that address the development and implementation of a consumer-first workforce development system required by the REACH Act.

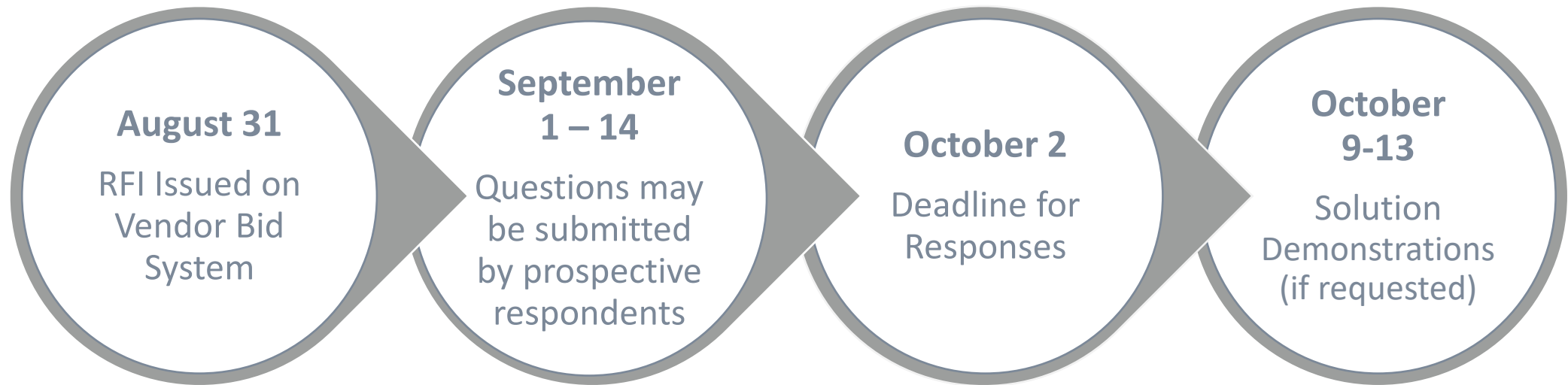


Request for Information (RFI) Highlights

- FloridaCommerce seeks information on current in-production (or recently designed) solutions to deliver the Customer Portal to include:
 - Full existing and planned future capabilities of any production solutions matching the Target Operating Model
 - Common Intake Form solutions
 - Agency staff worker capabilities of solutions
- Resources
 - Common Customer Portal Project Charter and Plan
 - Target Operating Model (initial)
 - Requirements Traceability Matrix (initial)
 - Updated Schedule IV-B
- Potential vendor demonstrations
 - FloridaCommerce reserves the right to contact and request specific RFI respondents to come back for a demonstration.

The Department will issue this RFI, and then:

- May request demonstrations
- Will issue a solicitation for services (procurement vehicle undecided)
