Subject: Hurricane Evacuation Modeling Follow Up Information

Dear Rebecca,

Based upon the follow-up information that was requested to be provided by Naval Air Station Key West (NASKW) to inform the statewide regional evacuation efforts, I provide the following. The number of dwelling units (south of the City of Marathon) associated with the Department of Defense (DoD), inclusive of the United States Coast Guard (USCG) and other tenant commands, are 2001 dwelling units. In addition to these dwelling units are four barracks that contain approximately 268 beds. It is estimated that the aforementioned facilities generate approximately 2,338 vehicles.

It is important to note that there are 124 wet slips as well as 550 recreational vehicle (RV) spaces. For the purposes of hurricane evacuation modeling, only 100 of the RV spaces were counted as contributing to both the unit and vehicle count during hurricane season (the estimated vehicle generation associated with the wet slips and 100 RV spaces were included in the 2,338 vehicle count).

The numbers provided represent a comprehensive analysis of family housing, permanent party bachelor quarters, transient facilities (military housing supportive of training, and short-term mission support), and vacation rentals (for active duty members, retirees, and authorized federal patrons). Based on all contributing elements, the total estimated number of vehicles is 2,338. Please note that this information is based off of the data and facilities available to date.
