

SUBJECT: Change to Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) 11-11, Selective Service Registration Requirements for Workforce Investment Act and Wagner-Peyser-Funded Programs

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Communiqué is to transmit Change 2 to Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) 11-11 which supersedes the previous two versions of this TEGL. The Change clarifies that local boards must have a policy in place that details when and how a Status Information Letter will need to be sought from the Selective Service and when and how the process will be initiated without first requesting the Status Information Letter for potential participants who are males 26 years old or older that failed to register with the Selective Service.
