EFM TIP: New Employer Registration Auto-Enable Function Turned Off

New employer registrations in the Employ Florida Marketplace (EFM) auto-enable after 72 hours if they have not been reviewed by staff. Due to the impending Thanksgiving holiday, staff of the Department of Economic Opportunity have turned off the auto-enable feature today so any new employer registrations and those who have not exceeded the 72 hour limit as of tonight will not be auto-enabled. Those employers and any new employer registering through the holiday weekend will not auto-enable until the feature is turned back on. Our plan is to turn the auto-enable process back on next Wednesday morning. This will give staff two business days to work those employers not already reviewed. The time clock continues to run even when the auto-enable feature is turned off so once we turn it back on any employer that has exceeded the time limit and has not been reviewed and enabled by staff will auto-enable Wednesday morning. Please ensure that you work your list starting with those employers with the oldest registration.
