SUBJECT: Entered Employment and Employment Retention Predictive Reports

New predictive reports are available for Workforce Investment Act (WIA) and Wagner-Peyser (WP) Entered Employment and Employment Retention measures based on preliminary Unemployment Insurance (UI) wage data. Queries for the predictive reports are attached. These reports will enable regions to target individuals for case management follow-up based upon individuals who are not found employed through preliminary UI wage data.

Official UI wage data, used for federal reporting, is usually available during the fifth month after the close of the quarter. The new preliminary data will be available 30 days after the end of the quarter and should include 80-90% of the UI wages that will be reported for the quarter. The preliminary data, however, will not include Wage Record Interchange System (WRIS) UI wage data, which is also utilized for federal reporting.

These reports will give regions a predictive entered employment and retention rate earlier, allowing regions 6 months to conduct targeted follow-up on individuals who were not found employed through the preliminary UI wage data.

<u>Quarter</u>	<u>Preliminary Data Available</u>	<u>Federal Report Submission</u>
January – March	May 1	The following November
April – Jun	August 1	The following February
July – September	November 1	The following May
October – December	February 1	The following August

Exiters without preliminary UI wages will be identified, allowing regions six months to do targeted follow-ups to identify and document employment that was not found in the preliminary UI wage data. When used, these new tools have the potential to positively impact region's Entered Employment and Employment Retention outcomes.
