

**SUBJECT:** Adjusted Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) Wage Rates for 2015

### **PURPOSE**

The U.S. Department of Labor issued the 2015 Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) on March 27, 2015. The attached tables convert the LLSIL to an hourly wage. The rates are adjusted for each workforce region based on the Florida Price Level Index, which measures the relative costs of maintaining a given standard of living across Florida counties served by the Regional Workforce Boards (RWB).

The hourly wage rates are used as baseline data in state generated performance reports such as the monthly management reports (MMRs) and may be used by RWBs for other purposes such as the locally required definition for employment that leads to self-sufficiency.
