

**SUBJECT:** Adjusted Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) Wage Rates for 2016



## **PURPOSE**

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity publishes the Adjusted LLSIL Wage Rates each year upon converting the LLSIL to an hourly wage. The attached tables reflect the adjusted rates. The rates are adjusted for each workforce area based on the Florida Price Level Index (FPLI). The FPLI measures the relative costs of maintaining a given standard of living across Florida counties served by the Local Workforce Development Boards (LWDBs).

The hourly wage rates are used as baseline data in state generated performance reports such as the monthly management reports (MMRs) and may be used by LWDBs for other purposes such as the locally required definition for employment that leads to self-sufficiency.
