SUBJECT: Review of Florida's Proposed Agricultural Outreach Plan for Program Year 2016

Federal regulations require the State to develop an Agricultural Outreach Plan which describes the provision of Wagner-Peyser Act services to Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers through the career center network. The U.S. Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration (ETA) now requires states to submit a Unified State Plan, which includes the complete Wagner-Peyser Agricultural Outreach Plan. A "draft" copy of Florida's proposed Agricultural Outreach Plan for Program Year (PY) 2016 is attached for your review and comment.
