Use of Pseudo Social security Numbers:</p> <p>We would suggest adding something regarding RA claimants, to the effect of: If an individual has filed an RA claim or will be filing a new RA claim, they must be informed that a pseudo SSN should not be created. The reason is; their EF user account will not cross match with the CONNECT system using a pseudo SSN, and they then will not be in compliance to meet their RA work test requirements.</p>	Peter Pignataro	RA claimants have no knowledge of the Pseudo SSN process.
