SUBJECT: 2023 Poverty Guidelines

On January 12, 2023, the United States Department of Health and Human Services published the 2023 poverty guidelines in the Federal Register. The guidelines became effective January 19, 2023. The poverty guidelines are used to calculate income levels to determine if individuals meet the mandated requirements for funded services in various workforce programs.

Persons in	Poverty
Household	Guideline
1	\$14,580
2	\$19.720
3	\$24,860
4	\$30,000
5	\$35 140
6	\$40 280
7	\$45 420
8	\$50,560

For families/households with more than eight (8) persons, add \$5,140 for each additional person.
