Office of Early Learning AWI-VPK 20 Addendum Qualifying Documents

A VPK provider who has met the statutory requirements for providing a VPK program may begin classroom instruction on the designated start date provided that the VPK provider can produce the documentation as it pertains to the VPK provider's program.

Below is a list of satisfactory documents that a coalition should accept in order to execute an addendum to the **VPK Provider Agreement**.

Birth through Five Child Care Credential or Child Development Associate Equivalent (CDA-E)

- Copy of application for CDA-E submitted to the Department of Children and Families.

Director Credential/Director Endorsement

- Copy of application submitted to the Department of Children and Families for processing.

Accreditation

- If available a status report from the accrediting body stating the expected result of the validation and when the accreditation certificate will be granted.
