

# All-Family Participation Rate

Family Type	Core Requirements	Total Requirements
Single parent with a child under the age of six	An average of 20 hours a week x 4.33 weeks a month= <b>87 hours monthly</b>	An average of 20 hours a week x 4.33 weeks a month= <b>87 hours monthly</b>
All other families	An average of 20 hours a week x 4.33 weeks a month= <b>87 hours monthly</b>	An average of 30 hours a week x 4.33 weeks a month= <b>130 hours monthly</b>

- The participation rate includes all families with at least one work-eligible parent
- Two-parent families must have at least one of the parents participating in the minimum required hours to be included in the numerator of the all-family rate. These hours must be reported in the data entry system

# Two-Parent Family Participation Rate

Family Type	Core Requirements	Total Requirements
Two-parent family not receiving federal funded subsidized childcare	An average of 30 hours a week x 4.33 weeks a month= <b>130 hours monthly</b>	An average of 35 hours a week x 4.33 weeks a month= <b>152 hours monthly</b>
Two-parent family receiving federal funded subsidized childcare	An average of 50 hours a week x 4.33 weeks a month= <b>217 hours monthly</b>	An average of 55 hours a week x 4.33 weeks a month= <b>238 hours monthly</b>

- The two-parent family participation rate only includes families with two work-eligible parents
- Two-parent families where one parent has a medical limitation lasting greater than 30 days recorded on the data entry system (as a deferral) will not be included in the two-parent family participation rate
