SUBJECT: Missing and Displaced Hurricanes Katrina and Rita Evacuees

Currently, there are still approximately 11,000 individuals who are missing or displaced as a result of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. The Louisiana Family Assistance Center (LFAC), one of the primary agencies involved in locating missing individuals, is trying to reunite families displaced by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. This is a free, non-profit service.

Please inform Hurricanes Katrina and Rita evacuees who visit the local One-Stop Career Centers that assistance in locating their family members may be obtained by calling LFAC at 1-866-326-9393 (toll-free). In addition, the evacuees should inform LFAC when the family members have been located or to provide additional information that may assist in finding the individuals missing.
