**SUBJECT:** Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Youth Program Transition

## PURPOSE

This communiqué transmits <u>Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) 23-14</u> which provides direction and planning information regarding WIA Title I youth formula funds under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). The TEGL addresses several important issues, such as:

- Out-of-School Youth (OSY) Expenditure Requirements
- Youth Standing Committees
- Transitioning In-School Youth (ISY) and Resources for Serving ISY
- Other Program Challenges program elements, expanded work experience focus, eligibility criteria, performance standards

The communiqué further provides examples of local areas that serve large numbers of OSY around the country, and lists a variety of additional resources, including webinars.
