SUBJECT: United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) myE-Verify

PURPOSE

This communiqué informs the Regional Workforce Boards (RWB) about a new tool available to job seekers and workers.

The USCIS launched a new web-based service called myE-Verify. MyE-Verify helps workers and job seekers prepare for the E-Verify process, used by employers to confirm employment eligibility, by informing workers and job seekers about their rights, employer responsibilities, as well as providing other free tools for job seekers to utilize in the process.

myE-Verify is offered at no cost to job seekers and workers. These services may be accessed at <u>http://www.uscis.gov/mye-verify/about-mye-verify</u>.
